Dream Centers imagines a community where the **cycles of poverty and abuse are broken**, where every mother and child experiencing homelessness can find a place to rebuild their lives, and where every woman has access to the highest quality women's health and mental health care.

You're working to make that **community a reality** as we continue to develop trauma informed programs and services to assist families, break down barriers, educate, encourage and empower.



GROWING YOUR IMPACT

With the purchase and remodeling of a four-unit apartment complex next to Mary's Home, you have catalyzed Dream Centers to serve four **additional families** in 2020. And as our numbers **continue to grow** at the Women's Clinic, renovations and updates are in the works for the Clinic in 2020.

Dream Centers is committed to continue to address **points of pain** in our community as we enter this new decade of providing health and hope in our community.

THE NUMBERS ARE STARTLING

10% of women in Colorado ages 18-44 were not covered in 2019 by public or private health insurance. Additionally, more than one in 10 women said they did not receive needed mental health care in the past year.

SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT

Each year in El Paso County, more than 2,000 students experience homelessness, or 1 in every 50. Adding children who are younger than age 6 makes this number as high as 1 in 18 children.

DREAM CENTERS WOMEN'S CLINIC

defines "success" as meeting the mental, physical and spiritual needs of uninsured and underinsured women and teens by providing free access to quality women's healthcare and mental health care.

Since the Dream Centers Women's Clinic began in 2011, the Clinic has served more than **10,000 women** and had nearly **50,000 patient contacts**.



DREAM CENTERS MARY'S HOME

defines "success" as a single parent mother who is able to graduate with holistic health and sufficient career resources so as to live a stable and successful life with minimal reliance on government assistance.

Since Dream Centers Mary's Home began in 2015, **21 families** have successfully exited our program. Last year, Mary's Home graduated **2 families**.

"If you would have told me two years ago, before entering Mary's Home, that I'd have a safe place to live and the opportunity to attend college and build a future for myself and my kids - I would have said you were crazy. Now, the dreams I never had are becoming my dreams AND my reality!"

In 2019, **7 resilient women** enrolled in higher education colleges or tech school programs and **5 moms** were employed.

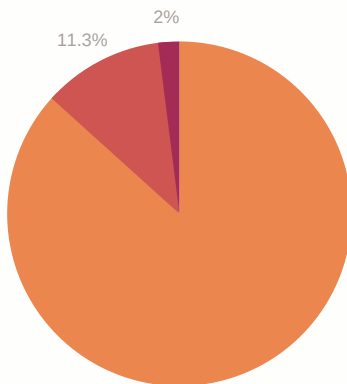

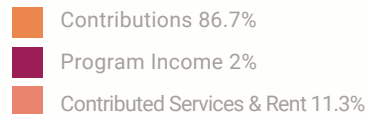
In 2019, through Dream Centers, you have invested over **\$2.5 million** in breaking the cycles of poverty and abuse, in women's health, and in women's mental health.

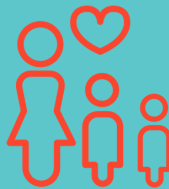

COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS

Dream Centers Women's Clinic had over 8,000 patient contacts with women and teens in need of women's health, mental health and resources.

Dream Centers Women's Clinic provided: 2,506 medical, 1,741 counseling, 1,478 chiropractic, 260 ultrasound, and 2,176 other services and referrals.

Dream Centers programs impact more than 1,300 uninsured and under-insured women and teens, and single mothers with young children experiencing homelessness.

Dream Centers Mary's Home provides a comprehensive and life-changing supportive housing program for 15 families to rebuild their dreams.

Dream Centers volunteers gave 19,223 volunteer hours, adding up to nearly half a million dollars in value for our clients and community.
